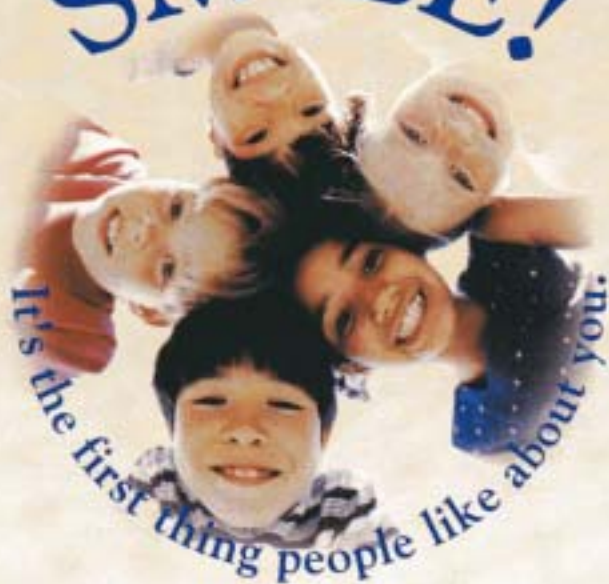

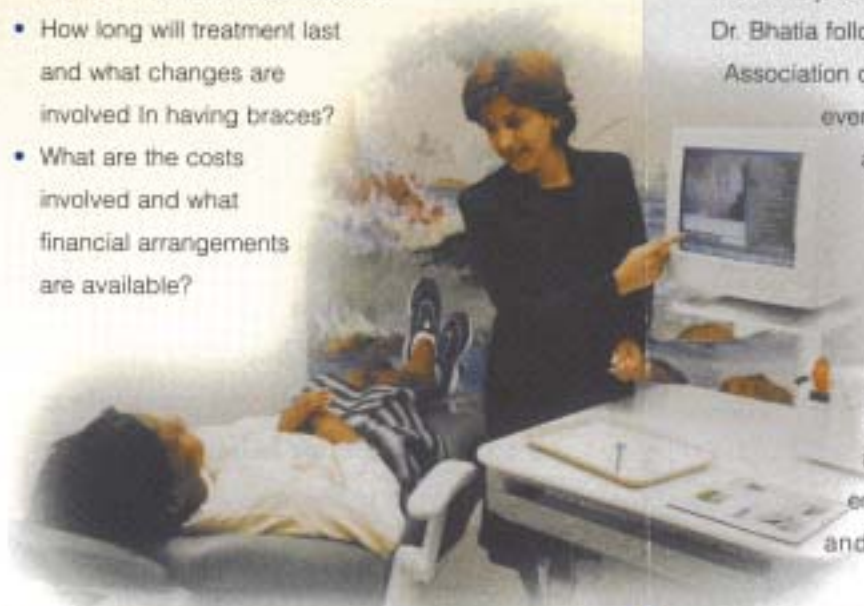
appointment for an evaluation at the request of your dentist, or you have identified a potential orthodontic concern, you will receive a thorough examination from Dr. Bhatia. With the

## Age 7, a Year to Remember

*“An early orthodontic exam allows us to determine how and when to best treat your child.”*

In the past, orthodontic treatment was often postponed until the adolescent years, when all the permanent teeth come into the mouth. We now know, that in many cases, early detection can significantly reduce the need for removal of permanent teeth and positive orthodontic results can be achieved that would only be possible while the face and jaws are still growing.

Dr. Bhatia follows the American

Association of Orthodontists' recommendation that every child have an orthodontic evaluation by age 7, or earlier if a problem is detected.

Although treatment may not begin at this young age, an early examination allows Dr. Bhatia to monitor your child's dental development through our "Growth and Guidance" program.
